Sophomores Class of 1956



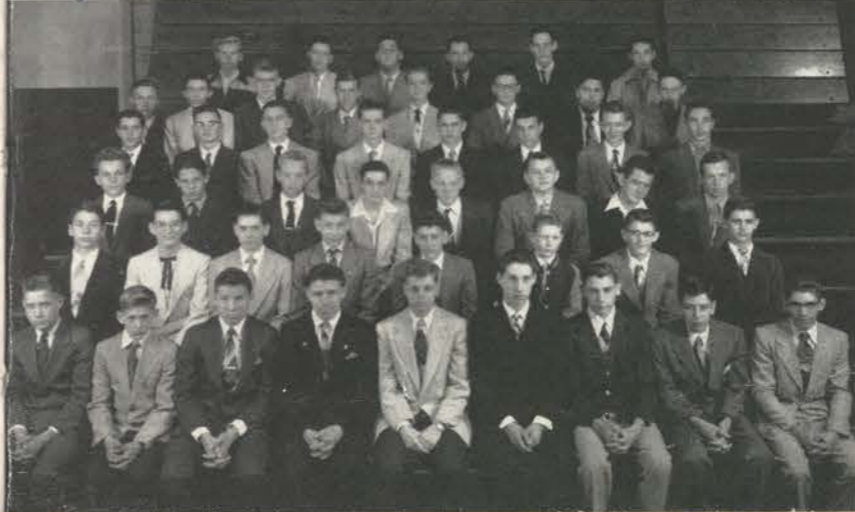
In September when the sophomores returned to school, they were happy and excited over the prospect of being, at last, senior high students.

Well on the way toward graduation is the class of 1955. In training to assume the responsibilities of the seniors, they work very closely with them in all of their activities and projects.

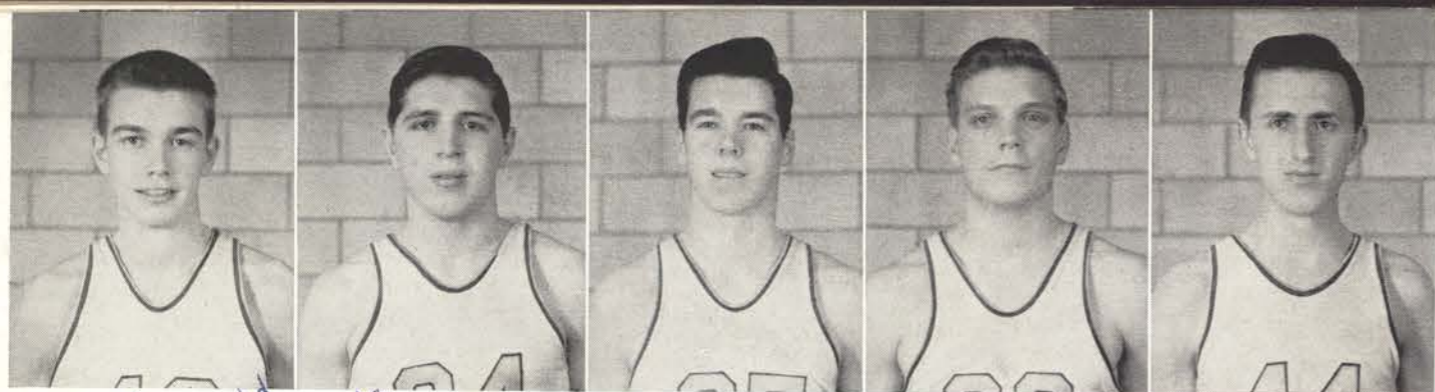
Among the most exciting moments of being a junior is the selection of a class ring and proudly wearing it. The Junior Prom is the outstanding social event of the year.

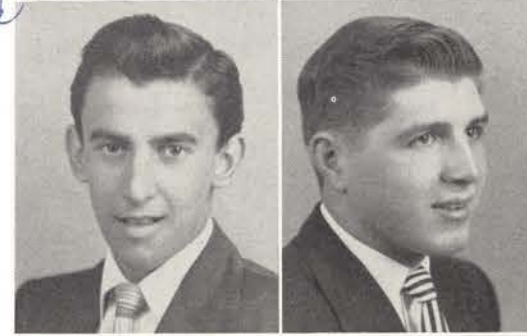
